Before your generous support

reached us, our school faced significant challenges that jeopardized the future of our children. Financial constraints made it difficult to pay our teachers the salaries they deserved.

Additionally, our commitment to instilling moral values through Biblical teachings encountered resistance from some parents outside our community. Sadly, the orphaned children who sought refuge, learning, and a chance at a better future often faced



ostracism. Their plight was compounded by societal stigmas; many children experienced mistreatment and exclusion, making it hard for them to study alongside their peers. This atmosphere of prejudice not only stifled the potential of the orphans but also created a divide that hindered the community and acceptance we aspired to cultivate within our school. Even the simple act of conducting morning prayers faced opposition, despite being an essential practice that promotes unity, peace, and spiritual growth among our students.

However, thanks to your unwavering support, we have turned a corner. Your contributions have lifted the financial burdens we once faced, enabling us to pay our teachers and maintain our staff, and



have fostered an atmosphere of acceptance, love, and joy. With your support, our orphan children can now pursue their education without fear of prejudice. They walk onto the school grounds every day with their heads held high, confident in their identities

and dreams, eager to learn and excited about their future.

We humbly ask for your continued prayers and full support. Despite our progress, many challenges still lie ahead. The needs of our orphaned children are significant, and their potential is limitless, provided we can offer them the tools, resources, and educational environment every child deserves. Your on-going generosity will directly impact their futures, allowing them to flourish as empowered individuals ready to take on the world.
