and interior forest areas. Our outreach is now not only flourishing in Andhra Pradesh but also extending into neighbouring states. We are particularly excited to share that our efforts in Tamil Nadu are thriving; allowing us to reach out to remote and

often overlooked rural regions. We are delighted to share that we visited Vellore, Tamil Nadu State this month too and conducted a gospel meeting in a village where we are planning to construct a Church Building. Presently, they have 45 members, and 10 others visit them every Lord's Day. They have already laid foundation and requested for completion of building. Thank you for your generous support in constructing buildings for local churches. Your love for God and His church is truly valued. The church keeps you in their daily prayers, expressing gratitude for your help.

Hundreds of children are lovingly cared for in our Children's Homes, which have been established and supported by your generosity. Here, they receive nutritious meals and quality education, and we are incredibly grateful for the much-needed infrastructure you have provided.

We are excited to announce that the dining hall and kitchen, which are nearing completion, will officially open in November 2025 during our brethren's visit to Rampachodavaram. This new facility will enable 250 children to dine together at the same time, creating a warm and communal atmosphere for their meals.

Thank you for your on-going support in their education. We are also pleased to share recent



photographs from our Independence Day celebration on August 15th. Thanks to your assistance, these children are not only learning to love their country but also deepening their faith in God.

We are also grateful for your efforts in extending God's love to countless widows in a society frequently marked by hatred. Because of our care for them, several abandoned women have found refuge in the widow's home. Some of these women have been abandoned for their faith and baptism. We are in the process of preparing to relocate these widows to a better facility within the same area. Currently, we are making arrangements to carry out necessary repairs to the home. Please keep us in your prayers.

Currently, over 100 preachers are undergoing Bible training and are eagerly anticipating graduation, ready to join us as we work together

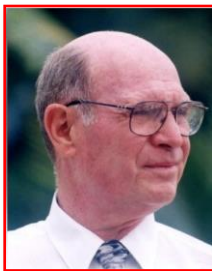
