Dear Brethren, We are filled with joy as we share the good news that our work is moving forward at a remarkable pace, despite facing some challenges along the way. Hindrances from Hindu fanatics, as well as flooding and heavy rains, have tested our commitment. However, our preaching brethren continue to persevere.

This month has been fruitful, as our preachers have reported 273 baptisms. In addition to this, we have held several Bible classes, house prayers and Gospel meetings, and we have also reached out to various new villages, expanding our mission and sharing the good news of Christ with those who have yet to hear His message. We are grateful for the P.A. systems (mobile) and bicycles that were given to the preachers. These help them travel to new villages, do street preaching with microphones, and hand out flyers and New Testaments. Additionally, our preachers have studied with several denominational preachers and invited them to the preachers' meeting. Though challenges arise, we are reminded that each step we take in faith is a step towards greater hope and transformation. Thank you for your continued support and prayers.

CHENNAI MISSION UPDATE: We are delighted to share that we recently visited the western part of Chennai, specifically Vellore, where we conducted a preachers' meeting. Each time we



visit this area, we conduct preachers' meeting at one preacher's location so that we take the opportunity to meet with each preacher at their respective locations, engage with



their congregations, understand their needs, and preach in their congregation and then we will have our meeting with preachers. We pay the expenses for food to the preacher of that location.

Currently, we are working with 35 preachers serving in various villages throughout Vellore and the Chittoor District, which borders Andhra Pradesh. The preachers face several challenges, most notably the urgent need for church buildings and a monthly financial support of \$50. They have expressed willingness to procure land and contribute their labor towards building efforts.

Unfortunately, the Lord's work in this region is considerably underserved and neglected. While some preachers have received training, they lack the necessary support to effectively spread the gospel. Brother Paul Joshua has been invaluable in assisting us in identifying these areas of need and also serves as our translator. As we look to the future, we are aiming to expand our work in this region. We kindly ask for your prayers and support in this endeavour. Additionally, there is an immediate need for Holy Bibles and songbooks in the Tamil language. Please keep these brethren in your prayers as we strive to uplift this neglected area. Thank you for your continued support.

ASHLYN HOME AT KATTAMURU: We are pleased to share that Ashlyn Home for Girls in Kattamuru continues to thrive, thanks to your on-going support. Currently, there are 23 girls residing in the home, studying from 2nd to 8th grade. Your generous assistance enables them to pursue their education while also introducing them to the true God. We welcome all children to our homes, regardless of their caste, creed, or religion. Through their time here, they discover the truth and, in turn, become not only responsible citizens but also exemplary citizens of heaven.



We are also delighted to report that Sister Terra Gobble from North Bradley Church visited the



girls' home on the 12th of this month. She mentioned that she has known Ashlyn since childhood and expressed her



joy at being able to visit the children. We are grateful for her visit and for the sponsors who have shown such love and support for these children. While going back, Sister Terra gave some money to buy Children and on the very day we bought blankets to the girls and distributed them. Additionally, we extend our heartfelt gratitude to all sponsors for their contributions to the children at Ramapachodavaram, Cheedipalem, Chinnuru, Suryapet, and various other locations.



SCHOOL OF PREACHING AT KATTAMURU: We express our heartfelt gratitude for your support of the preacher students at Kattamuru. We sincerely appreciate your on-going support for the salaries of our staff, doctors, and provision of medicines. We would also like to express our gratitude to Brother Ted Gaw for his continuous assistance with the dental clinic, which is the only facility in the region addressing dental issues. While there is a government-run area hospital and several first aid clinics nearby, our hospital stands out as the sole dental clinic in this entire locality. It serves as a beacon of hope, demonstrating the love of Christ through the medical services we offer to all members of society, regardless of creed or religion. Furthermore, this facility is a significant asset for the widows of our church and the surrounding community.

We extend our heartfelt thanks to the dedicated doctors working at the hospital. Finding a physician willing to serve in a remote area like Rampachodavaram poses its challenges. Many choose to work in urban settings for higher salaries and better amenities. Following the passing of Dr. Reddy, who was a devoted and committed individual, we faced difficulties in finding a full-time doctor until we recruited Dr. Himabindu, who is currently with us. We have reached out to several doctors in the past, yet many did not stay long.



Dr. Samyuktha, who is a dentist and a church member, is preparing to relocate for her upcoming marriage. She has been a faithful and dedicated member of our team. We kindly ask for your prayers in our search for another God-fearing dentist to join our mission.



Mrs. Reddy(Sis. Prasanna) continues to work at the hospital, overseeing all medical operations following Dr. Reddy's passing. We are grateful to the brethren for this great facility, which serves hundreds of people to receive care and experience the love of God, ultimately guiding them toward accepting Him.
